The New Zealand Institute of International Affairs (NZIIA) was established in 1934. It is an independent non-governmental organisation which seeks to promote discussion and understanding of international issues and emerging trends, particularly as they relate to New Zealand.

The Wairarapa Branch founded in 1997 achieves the purpose of the NZIIA through the voluntary work of an elected committee. The committee organises events such as speakers, forums, screening of films and hosts book launches. Speakers include diplomatic representatives, non-Government Organisations, defence personnel and academics amongst others. The Branch usually has one function per month.

The Wairarapa Branch charges an annual subscription covering the calendar year (1 January to 31 December). Membership includes a subscription to the bi-monthly magazine the 'New Zealand International Review'. The periodical is devoted entirely to affairs internationally.

Non-members are invited to attend a meeting before making the decision to join the branch, with a donation towards the cost of the meeting.
